#### Enville Brewery - Cox Green, Stourbridge

Brewers of award winning cask ales since 1993. Their range has grown as demand for variety has encouraged them to introduce ales which satisfy a wide range of tastes.

#### Gloucester Brewery - Gloucester

Situated in Gloucester's historic docks, brewing began in 2011. Their award winning ales are often cutting edge.

#### Hobson's Brewery - Kidderminster, Shropshire

Founded by the Davis family over 20 years ago, Hobson's have grown to become a leading brewer in Shropshire, one of the most sustainable breweries in the UK and now produces 180-200 barrels per week.

#### Marston's Brewery - Wolverhampton

Marston's started brewing in Burton-on-Trent in 1834 and that makes them the oldest Brewer in Burton. They went to Burton for the water and the rocks that the town was built upon to be precise. The Water trickles down through a thick layer of Gypsum before being brought back up again through their own well. This gives the beers the depth of flavour, character and crisp refreshing bitterness that you won't find anywhere in the world.

#### Monty's Hendomen - Montgomery.

Monty's began in 2009 and also operates two pubs in the local area.

#### Purity - Alcester, Warwickshire

Purity Brewing Company is an award winning craft brewery established in 2005. Based on a working farm in the heart of the beautiful Warwickshire countryside, Purity are committed to brewing beer with a conscience. Purity is a name synonymous with music and the arts, our customers are discerning when it comes to culture and accordingly they are discerning when it comes to the beer they drink.

#### Salopian Brewery - Hadnall, Shrewsbury

Originally founded as Snowdonia Brewery in 1994 in North Wales and renamed 'Salopian' meaning 'native of Shropshire' upon relocation to Shrewsbury in '95. Production of their fine cask ales has rapidly increased since then and continues to do so.

#### Sarah Hughes Brewery - Sedgley, West Midlands

Began to brew the famous Dark Ruby Mild out of the Beacon Hotel in 1921 and after lying idle for 30 years the brewery was reopened by her grandson who continues to use the traditional recipe to this day.

#### Stonehouse Brewery - Weston, Shropshire

A family run brewery established in 2007. The brewery sits next to the preserved Cambrian railway line. A welcome return to SFF after 5 years.

#### Three Tuns Brewery - Bishop's Castle, Shropshire

Brewed in a classic miniature Victorian tower, their exceptional beer leaves a taste to be remembered. Using their own strain of 'Three Tuns Yeast' they weave their own special magic in to each brew.

#### Titanic Brewery - Burslem, Stoke on Trent

#### Cotswold Cider Co - Oxfordshire

Apples are our passion and our calling is to craft full-flavoured cider with bags of character and spirited personality. Only ever fermented from 100% apple juice using English bittersweet cider apples for that true, honest, full-blooded real good cider, without compromise. We think real cider is so utterly awesome that more people should know about it both in this country... and beyond (there's no stopping us!)

#### Fleece Inn - Bretforton, Worcestershire

Nigel and his team make cider every autumn from apples grown in the Fleece orchard and supplied by locals at the annual Apple and Ale Festivities. This year's batch is a real winner and shows the renewed commitment to the craft that leads to a real Real cider.

#### Hogan's Cider - Alcester, Warwickshire

Produced in the Malvern Hills, Hogan's is made from freshly pressed cider apples grown in the Three Counties - Gloucestershire, Herefordshire and Worcestershire. Their multi award winning products are now exported all over the world.

Rosie's Pig (Westons) - Much Marcle, Herefordshire
Rosie's Pig, was one of the first delivery trucks Westons Cider ever
owned. 'A pig to start, and a pig to drive' was how the saying
went. Rosie's Pig still lives in the yard next to Old Rosie the steam
