### Envile Brewery - Cox Green, Stourbridge

Brewers of award-winning cask ales since 1993. Their range has grown as demand for variety has encouraged them to introduce ales which satisfy a wide range of tastes.

### Hobsons Brewery - Cleobury Mortimer, Shropshire

An independent local brewery, all of their beers are brewed using locally grown Maris Otter Malting barley, 80% are with British hops from Brook House Hops (some 20 miles away) and Hobsons House Yeast –unique to Hobson's beers with its own flavour characteristic.

### North Cotswold

### Purity - Alcester, Warwickshire

### Salopian Brewery - Hadnall, Shrewsbury
