

Alphabetical order by Brewer

| Brewer | Ale | ABV% | Style | Description | |
|---------------------|---------------|------|---------|---|---|
| Enville | Ale | 4.5 | Amber | Based on a 19th Century recipe, light in colour with fruity notes and a hint of sweetness to compliment the dry hoppy taste. Brewed using Maris Otter floor malted barley and specially selected honeys. |  |
| Enville | Ginger | 4.6 | Special | A speciality ale carefully infused with root extract of ginger to impart a memorable flavour which is both subtle and refreshing without overpowering. |  |
| Hobsons | Cor Blimey | 4.5 | Amber | Sweet, smooth honey-like flavour profile balanced with a subtle bitterness. Brewed with British Goldings and Progress, Maris Otter malting barley and Crystal Malt provide a deep amber colour. |  |
| Hobsons | Mild | 3.2 | Dark | A smooth character and taste, notes of chocolate malt gives this beer plenty of flavour and aroma. Previous CAMRA Champion Beer of Britain. |  |
| Hobsons | Old Prickly | 4.2 | Pale | Snuffly Hedge Grog. Pale easy-drinking full-flavoured ale with a sweet character and floral notes – not at all prickly! |  |
| Hobsons | Town Crier | 4.5 | Gold | A beer to shout about, a most popular crisp full-flavoured golden ale brewed with British hops. |  |
| Hobsons | Twisted Spire | 3.5 | Gold | A beer with a real twist, light and refreshing with a full, up front hop flavour followed by a crisp bitterness and citrus aromas. All round appeal! |  |
| Noble Craft Brewing | Blonde | 3.7 | Pale | A fan favourite, a very fruity and smooth refreshing session ale, with a delicious crisp and dry finish. Designed with British hops to create a blend of spice, herbal and honey which creates this easy drinking smooth ale. |  |
| Noble Craft Brewing | Crusade | 4 | Pale | An award-winning pale ale, extremely fruity, with rich aroma and taste, notes of passion fruit, grapefruit and white grape, and a nice dry and bitter finish. A rich and hoppy flavour. |  |

| Noble Craft Brewing | Kingdom | 4.4 | Pale | A pale ale that stands out from the rest with its forestry fruity, pine and citrus flavour, has a smooth texture for easy drinking. |  |
| North Cotswold | Cotswold Best | 4 | Brown | Copper, biscuity, easy drinking. |  |
| North Cotswold | Black Jack IPA | 6 | Dark | Intense black hoppy IPA. |  |
| North Cotswold | Green Man IPA | 4 | Pale | Light golden, very refreshing double hopped. |  |
| North Cotswold | Hung, Drawn & Double Portered | 6.1 | Dark | Dark and smooth award winning porter infused with port. |  |
| North Cotswold | Não Faz Mal | 5.6 | Pale | Earthy fruity hoppy IPA. |  |
| North Cotswold | Shag weaver | 4.5 | Brown | Golden, fruity, moreish. |  |
| Purity | Bunny Hop | 3.5 | Pale VE GF | A hazy pale ale that is vegan & gluten free! Dry hopped with El Dorado, Centennial and Azacca, oats enhance the haziness. A bold beer, which perfectly balances its low abv, pale malts and powerful hops with an IBU 55. |  |
| Purity | Jimbo | 4 | Brown VE GF | Brewed with Pilgrim for that initial bitterness then classics Fuggles and Goldings as well as Emperor. Aromas of mixed berries, crisp apple, all balanced with a well-rounded nutty bitter finish. |  |
| Purity | Mad Goose | 4.2 | Pale VE | A zesty pale ale with a smooth and citrusy finish. English Maris Otter, Caragold and Wheat malts, with Hallertau Northern Brewer bittering hops and Cascade and Willamette aroma hops. |  |

| Salopian | Accelerator | 3.9 | Gold | A vibrant straw coloured ale bursting with citrus aromas, a strong palate of mango and grapefruit and a refreshing bitter finish. |  |
| Salopian | Darwin's Original | 4.5 | Copper | A copper coloured Bitter given an international twist with an eclectic mix of new and old world hops that give the beer its distinctive lemony aroma and dry finish. |  |
| Salopian | Golden Thread | 5 | Gold | A bright gold ale, using wheat and lager malt and flavoured with an infusion of aroma hops. Clean and crisp to the palate with a hint of sweetness and a long fruit filled finish. |  |
| Salopian | Hop Twister | 4.4 | Gold | The palate is fresh, piercing and focused, with soft malt overtones and pronounced citrus flavours. A strong focus of taut, lemony, grapefruit on the finish which is balanced by a dry bitterness. |  |
| Salopian | Lemon Dream | 4.5 | Special | A shimmering golden ale that is brewed using organic lemons which adds beautifully subtle zesty aromas and a citrus filled fruity finish. |  |
| Salopian | Oracle | 4 | Gold | A crisp, sparkingly sunflower gold ale with a striking hop profile. Dry and refreshing with a long citrus aromatic finish. |  |
| Salopian | Shropshire Gold | 3.8 | Gold | Golden with a floral aroma and a full hoppy flavour that is balanced by a crisp dry maltiness and a rich finish. |  |
| Three Tuns | Best | 3.8 | Amber | Fruit, biscuit, caramel. A most traditional amber ale. All English hop varieties, Marris otter malts. Rich and smooth throughout with a pleasing long bitter-sweet finish. |  |
| Three Tuns | Solstice | 3.9 | Gold | Zesty fruits, honey. Light, refreshing and crisp, a malty straw-coloured ale embodying midsummer. Layered with zesty flavours that bring a delicious floral-fruity bitterness, one for those blissful long days. |  |
| Three Tuns | Stout | 4.4 | Dark | Dried fruits, caramel, cocoa. Black and smooth, creamy old fashioned stout. |  |

| Three Tuns | XXX | 4.3 | Pale | Fruit, honey, bread. A renowned beer from a recipe passed down by the Roberts family, pale-straw-coloured, premium bitter with simple, light malty sweetness, delicate with light bitterness of floral, earthy character. |  |
| Titanic | Plum Porter | 4.9 | Dark | Award-winning, dark, strong and well rounded, the richness of such a rotund beer is brought to an even keel by the late addition of Golding's hops and natural plum flavouring. |  |
| Wye Valley | Butty Bach | 4.5 | Gold | 'Butty Bach' is Welsh meaning 'little friend'. This smooth and satisfying premium ale is brewed using Maris Otter and Crystal malts, flaked barley, malted wheat, and locally grown Fuggles, Goldings and Bramling Cross hops. |  |
| Wye Valley | HPA | 4 | Pale | A delightful straw coloured ale with a delicate hop aroma, a hint of sweetness before a dry finish. |  |
| Wye Valley | Wholesome Stout | 4.6 | Dark | A classic stout with intense roasted barley flavours and a dry bitter finish. |  |

| Abrahall's Herefordshire | Dry | 6 | Dry | A well rounded, easy to drink, dry cider, made from 100% cider apples - a blend of bitter sweet and sharp – Dabinett, Michelin and a smattering of Kingston Black, the old cidemaker's favourite. |  |
| Abrahall's Herefordshire | Medium | 6 | Medium | Well-rounded and easy drinking, made from bittersweet and sharp cider apples – Dabinett, Michelin and Kingston Black - that are allowed to fully ripen bringing out a full flavour. |  |
| Celtic Marches Herefordshire | Cuckoo Penny Rhubarb | 4 | Fruit | This beautiful blend of real Yorkshire Triangle rhubarb juice and Herefordshire craft cider is enriched with the subtle tart of fresh rhubarb giving it a soft, sweet and refreshing bite. |  |
| Celtic Marches Herefordshire | Strawberry & Lime | 4.5 | Fruit | A bursting blend of citrus and sweet. It has a sweet, fresh-crushed strawberry nose and a subtle, zingy, citrus finishing note of lime. Carefully balanced and lightly mellowed. |  |
| Celtic Marches Herefordshire | Wild Berries | 4 | Fruit | Medium craft cider bursting with the quintessential taste of the Herefordshire hedgerow. A rich blend of wild berries creates its deep crimson tone. |  |
| Hogan's Warwickshire | French Revelation | 4.8 | Sweet Tannic | A revelation by name and by nature, this is something a little different. This fresh pressed drop is smooth and velvety with a big tannic punch followed by fruit sweetness. |  |
| Hogan's Warwickshire | Harvest Press | 5.3 | Medium Dry | Appley aroma with peaty undertones, this medium dry cider is just challenging enough to be easy drinking. A real taste of the orchard. |  |

| Long Mynd Shropshire | Original Sweet | 6.5 | Sweet | ...and more of that glorious appley summer, clotted cream, apple crumble, warmth. Still and cloudy. |  |
| Pulp Herefordshire | Damson | 3.4 | Fruit | The juicy fruit, combined with our real cider apples creates a delicately sweet, full of flavour, medium bodied tipple with a soft apple nose-No Damson in distress! |  |
| Snails Bank Herefordshire | Apple Hog | 4.5 | Medium | Dabinett & Michelin apples are blended here to present a very interesting full Medium Cider. |  |
