







Alphabetical order by Brewer

Brewer	Ale	ABV%	Style	Description	
Black Sheep	Bitter	3.8	Amber	Bold, refreshing bitterness at the fore, leading to complex malt and grassy hop flavours. Eminently supple.	
Enville	Ale	4.5	Amber	Based on a 19th Century recipe, light colour with fruity notes and a hint of sweetness to compliment the dry hoppy taste. Maris Otter floor malted barley and specially selected honeys.	
Enville	Ginger	4.5	Special	A speciality ale carefully infused with root extract of ginger to impart a memorable flavour which is both subtle and refreshing without overpowering.	
Hobsons	Easy Days	3.4	Pale	Motueka and Centennial hops bring out crisp citrus notes. A clean and easy-drinking pale ale with just the right amount of bitterness and a light malt backbone to keep things smooth.	
Hobsons	Mild	3.2	Dark	A smooth character and taste, notes of chocolate malt gives this beer plenty of flavour and aroma. Previous CAMRA Champion Beer of Britain.	
Hobsons	Old Prickly	4.2	Pale	Snuffly Hedge Grog. Pale easy-drinking full-flavoured ale with a sweet character and floral notes – not at all prickly!	
Hobsons	Town Crier	4.5	Gold	A beer to shout about, a most popular crisp full-flavoured golden ale brewed with British hops.	
Hobsons	Twisted Spire	3.5	Gold	A beer with a real twist, light and refreshing with a full, up front hop flavour followed by a crisp bitterness and citrus aromas. All round appeal!	
North Cotswold	Cotswold Best	4	Brown	Copper, biscuity and easy drinking.	
North Cotswold	Moreton Mild	3.8	Dark	Award winning rich smooth dark mild with a nutty palate. Named after the Cotswold market town of Moreton in Marsh.

Purity	Bunny Hop	3.5	Pale VE GF	Dry hopped with El Dorado, Centennial and Azacca, oats enhance the haziness. A bold beer, which perfectly balances its low abv, pale malts and powerful hops.

Salopian	Darwin's Original	4.5	Copper	A copper coloured Bitter given an international twist with an eclectic mix of new and old world hops that give the beer its distinctive lemony aroma and dry finish.	
Salopian	Escape Velocity	4.2	Pale	A fiery golden ale with a pungent grapefruit aroma, lemon and citrus flavours,	
Salopian	Golden Thread	5	Gold	A bright gold ale, using wheat and lager malt and flavoured with an infusion of aroma hops. Clean and crisp to the palate with a hint of sweetness and a long fruit filled finish.	
Salopian	Hop Twister	4.4	Gold	Fresh, piercing and focused palate, with soft malt overtones and pronounced citrus flavours. Taut lemony, grapefruit on the finish is balanced by a dry bitterness.



Abrahall's Herefordshire	Medium	6	Medium	Well-rounded and easy drinking, made from bittersweet and sharp cider apples – Dabinett, Michelin and Kingston Black - that are allowed to fully ripen bringing out a full flavour.	
Celtic Marches Herefordshire	Alice	4.6	Medium Dry	Well-rounded cider with a moreish sharpness. Smooth and mellow with a very slight tart finish.
